

DIRECTIONS TO HAY CREEK RANCH

WARNING: Do NOT use Mapquest, Google, or any other internet service for directions to our camp; they are either incomplete or incorrect!

Off I-90

If you are coming to the Black Hills from the east you might find it difficult to find your way through Rapid City to Nemo Road. Here are directions to get you off I-90, onto Nemo Road, and to Hay Creek Ranch.

1. Get off I-90 at Exit 55. This is the Deadwood Ave. exit.
2. From the stoplight at Exit 55 go south (left) 2.3 miles. You will be going downhill. At the bottom of the hill Deadwood Ave. intersects with W. Omaha/W. Chicago.
3. Turn west (right) on W. Chicago. It is 1.1 miles to the stop light at Sturgis Rd. Keep going west on W. Chicago. You are now in a residential area.
4. At the 44th St. stoplight you will veer to the right and the road becomes South Canyon Rd. Stay on South Canyon Rd. as it starts to wind up into the Hills.
5. There isn't any sign, but South Canyon Rd. turns into Nemo Rd.
6. Stay on Nemo Rd., passing through Nemo, all the way to Corral Creek Rd., which is approximately 10.9 miles northwest of Nemo. Look for the blue sign that reads HAY CREEK RANCH CAMP.
7. Turn south (left) on Corral Creek Rd.
8. Stay on Corral Creek Road for approximately 1.8 miles and then veer to the left onto Lucky Strike.
9. Continue on Lucky Strike (Forest Service Road 582.2) for 1.8 miles.
10. Look for the sign on the dead tree marking Forest Service Road 582.2E. You will turn left onto 582.2E. (The Forest Service made us take down our Hay Creek Ranch sign so be alert!)
11. Stay on FS Rd. 582.2E for 0.6 miles and watch for the Hay Creek Ranch gate on your right.

From US 385 to Hay Creek Ranch (6.4 miles)

1. Turn east onto Nemo Road.
2. Go east 2.2 miles and turn south (right) onto Corral Creek Road.
3. Go 0.6 miles and cross the cattle guard.
4. Continue south another 0.5 miles and pass the intersection with Rockland Road.
5. 0.7 miles past Rockland Road you will veer to the left onto Lucky Strike.
6. Continue on Lucky Strike (Forest Service Road 582.2) for 1.8 miles.
7. Look for the sign on the dead tree. Turn left onto Forest Service Road 582.2E just before the dead tree and continue for 0.6 miles.
8. The gate to Hay Creek Ranch will be on your right.
